



Technical Support Instrument (TSI)

- In 2018, the European Commission contracted the Agency to technically support the ministries of education of Poland and Cyprus in their on-going work towards developing inclusive education systems. In 2019 this work extended to Greece and the Czech Republic, and to Portugal in 2020.
- The work includes:
 - Analyses of existing education systems' strengths and weaknesses
 - Recommendations for priority actions
 - Support in developing legislative reforms for implementing inclusive education



New TSI actions as of 2022 with a duration of 2 years

- A multi-country activity in Spain, Portugal and Italy focusing on 'Combatting disparities in access to inclusive education in Portugal, Italy and Spain'.
- A continuation of the current action in Greece, with a focus on transforming the principles and policy guidelines that have been prepared into daily educational practice.
- An action in France focusing on 'Enhance the French App for inclusive education'
