## EU Policy Webinar on the implementation of the European Child Guarantee

#### **Background**

EU Member States agreed through the Article 11(c) of the Council Recommendation establishing a European Child Guarantee to submit National Action Plans on the implementation of the European Child Guarantee (NAPs) by the 15<sup>th</sup> of March 2022. These should include actions across the four identified areas notably through targeted measures for the different target groups identified considering the national circumstances.

COFACE advocates for a **two-generation approach** in policy and practice to tackle child poverty, which is based on the interrelated well-being of children and their caregivers, as highlighted in the COFACE Child Compass 2030.<sup>2</sup> This is the vision that was put forward in the Child Guarantee adopting a two-generation approach.

To support the development and implementation of the Child Guarantee, COFACE and the Association of German Family Organisations (COFACE member), has already jointly organised two expert meetings in Berlin bringing together civil society organisations and family policy-makers.<sup>3</sup>

#### Objectives of the EU policy webinar

This webinar will bring together speakers from the EU institutions, and participants from different fields and backgrounds in order to:

- Discuss tools for monitoring and evaluation of Child Guarantee implementation;
- Foster stronger links between different policy and funding initiatives taken at EU and national level;
- Share knowledge from national and EU level in order to strengthen the policy and funding levers to boost implementation;
- Develop recommendations to feed into frameworks which are key in the implementation process such as the National Action Plan reviews, the EU Child Guarantee Monitoring and Evaluation Framework, the mid-term review of the EU Multiannual Financial Framework, and the future of EU Cohesion policy.
