59 million persons with a hearing disability (EFHOH 2024)

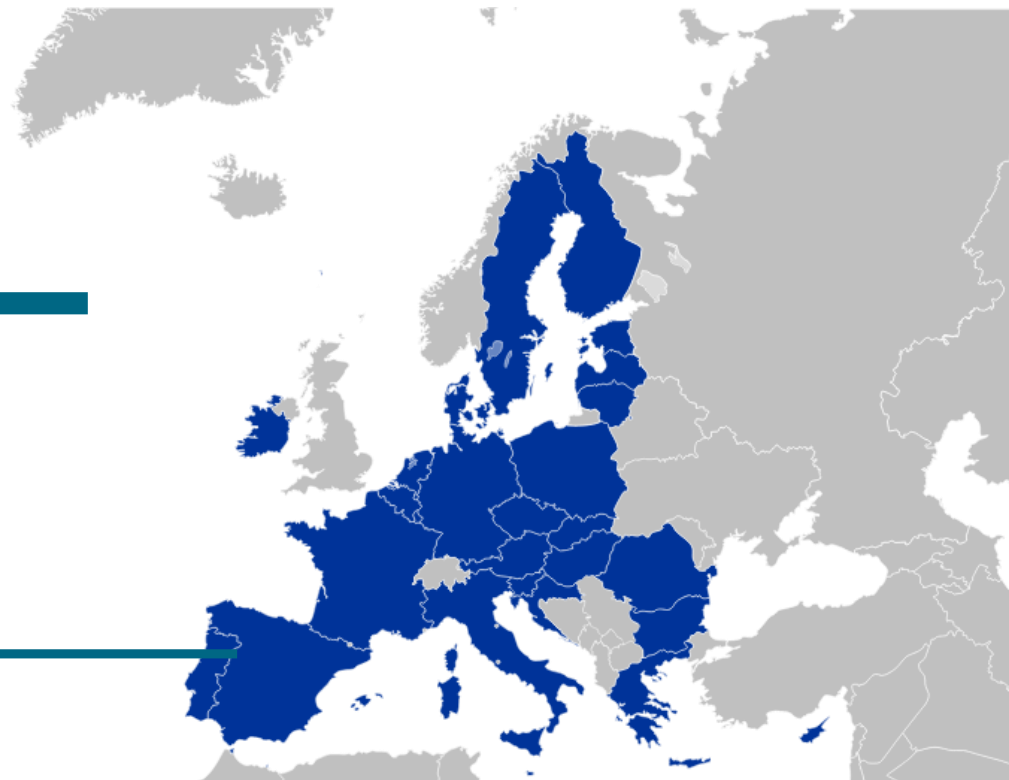
0,5 M millions of persons communicates in sign language (E.Parliament 2018)



SPAIN

1.230.000 persons with a hearing disability (INE 2020)

27.300 persons communicates in sign language (INE 2020)

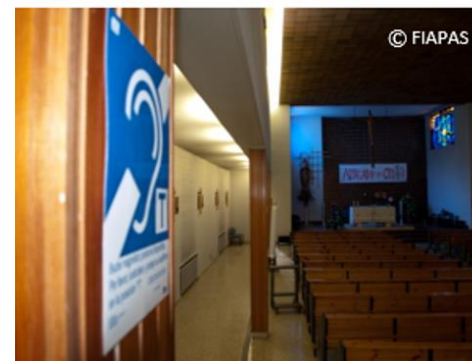
IT DEPENDS ON THE LANGUAGE OF COMMUNICATION

- People with a hearing disability who communicate in oral language, users of hearing aids, need hearing assistive devices for hearing accessibility and oral communication support resources.
- People who use sign language need sign language interpreters.

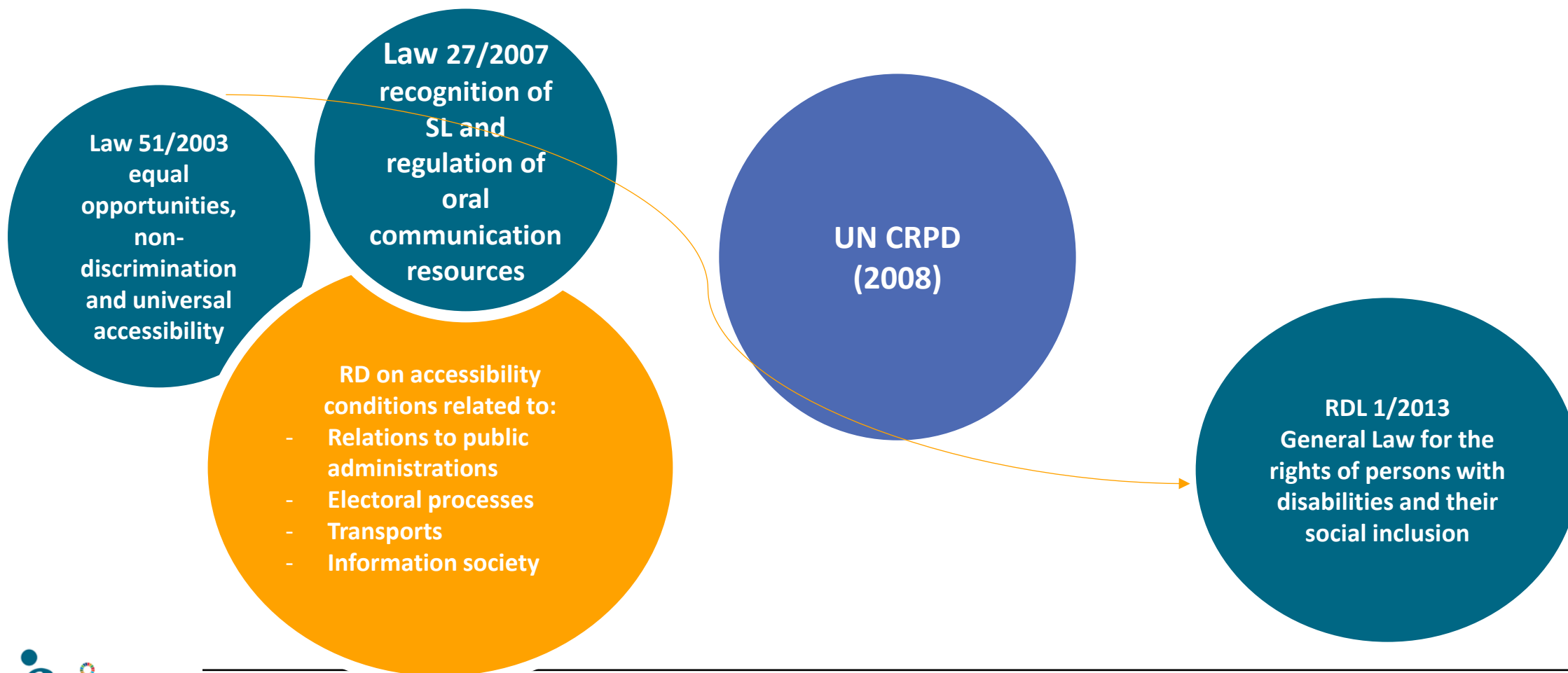
