






Central location House of the Child Hasselt

Challenges of Working Together



- We <u>together</u> are the House of the Child: a shared and collective vision that goes beyond our individual parent organizations.
- Create <u>engagement</u> and <u>ownership</u>: Organize network meetings and steering groups, ensure relevant information flow, include agenda items from all partners, share updates, invite local policymakers or aldermen, and keep everyone involved.
- Always consider: "What's in it for me?": The motivations and needs of each partner.
- A clear <u>coordinator</u> is essential: Someone who oversees the whole process, keeps it on track, and serves as a recognisable contact point for all partners.
- Acknowledge and make use of each partner's expertise.
- Allow space for informal exchange: It helps <u>strengthen relationships</u> and <u>trust</u>, and: share a meal!
- Organise <u>training</u> for <u>professionals:</u> Focus on their needs and priorities and make full use of your facilitating role to support and empower them.

1. Preventive medical consultation office by 'Kind en Gezin'

- 3x/a week in/during (reception of) House of the Child Hasselt
- Thematic sessions for parents and professionals
 - Potty training
 - Toddler puberty
 - Sleeping and nutrition
- Individuel parenting support for parents with children 0 – 3
- Family support (outreach) for families in vulnerable situations





1. Preventive medical consultation office by 'Kind en Gezin'



Reach in 2024

- √ 1945 appointmens
- √ 648 unique children

2. Meeting places and social cohesion



- Open and free meeting places/occasions
 - Play- and meetingroom in House of the Child Hasselt
 - Waiting room consultation office
- Organized meeting places for parents with children
 - 'Peuternestjes' (0 3 jaar) (transl. 'toddler nests')
 - Speelnest Banneux (0 6 jaar) (transl. 'play nest')
 - Koffiepraat (0 12 jaar) (transl. 'coffee talk')
- Other activities with a 'meeting-component'
 - Fostercare appreciation event
 - Children's theater
 - Summertrip with picnic at the beginning of the summer holidays



2. Meeting places and social cohesion

Reach in 2024

- ✓ Toddler nests
 - Took place 200 times
 - 1564 parents | 1366 children
- ✓ Play nest and coffee talk
 - Took place 82 times
 - 728 parents | 1118 children









3. Group work

- Based on needs a varied annual program
- Infosessions, workshops and lectures
 - For parents, professionals, students and volunteers
- Thematic group series for parents or children
 - Pregnancy, baby, toddler
 - Autism, divorce, nonviolent resistance, emotion regulation, resilience

Reach in 2024

- √ 113 activities
 - o <mark>1466</mark> parents
 - o <mark>1235</mark> children
 - 422 professionals
 - 156 students

4. Individual support





- Thematic services in House of the Child Hasselt
 - Childcare
 - Child benefits ('Groeipakket')
 - Coach for children's rights
 - Leisure, sports and culture

Walk-in, no appointment

- Parentel and mental support
 - Parenting store: parental advice
 - Primary care psychologist (mild/moderate problems)
- Material support
 - Swap shop 'het Wisselke' (physical store)
 - Swap shop 'De Uitwissel' (webshop)
 - Toy library

Reach in 2024

- Thematic rooms in House of the Child Hasselt
 - Childcare: 62 appointments
- Parentel and mental support
 - Individual parental support: 197 consultations
 - Primary care psychologist: 190 trajects
- Material support
 - Swap shop 'het Wisselke' (physical store)
 - 2909 visitors
 - 2952 families with a swap-card
 - Swap shop 'De Uitwissel' (webshop)
 - 376 orders and donations
 - 185 families with a swap-card
 - Toy library
 - **1618** visitors
 - 999 families with a membercard

Reception: Philosophy and approach


- 3-phase approach:

Low threshold and accessible


- Warm, open and reliable reception workers




How do people find their way to the House of the Child Hasselt?




Who finds their way to the House of the Child Hasselt (2024)?
